Our membership data is shared with the British Beekeepers Association (BBKA), the country's largest charity dedicated to helping Honeybees and the beekeepers that look after them, and also with the Yorkshire Beekeepers Association (YBKA).</p> <p>Your data may be processed by the YBKA and the BBKA acting as Data Processors on our behalf. They may only use it for the specific purposes for which they act as our data processors and they are not free to pass this on to other organisations that are not connected with the Airedale Beekeepers Association.</p> <p>Your personal data is not passed on by us for use by any other third parties whether or not connected with beekeeping.
